hands and being able to constantly walk in victory over the enemy of your soul.

That is the depth of victory we have received as believers in Christ Jesus.

Listen, the subject of faith is a matter that has been overly written on. The weight of materials available on this matter is so great you should think that too many believers will be walking in the triumph Christ has for them.

But the reverse is the case.

It seems the more we hear about faith, the more we are unable to fully walk in the fullness of faith that God wants us to. Jesus Himself said, "When the Son of man returns, will He find faith on earth?" (Luke 18:8). Will He find those who believe Him fully and completely on earth when He returns?

You should be up to receiving the results of a faith walk in the next 30 days. (By the way, don't beat yourself up if you do miss a day. Dust yourself up and get right back in to reading and building your faith. Kids don't learn to walk in a day).

This book is not a *one size fits all*. It's not a "faith capsule" that would shoot up your faith, keeping it there permanently. As long as we're in this world, we will always have to grow our faith in God I am constantly looking for ways to grow my faith. But over the years, there has been no book strongest enough to do that than the Word of God. So I advise that you vigorously fill your mind with God's Word even as you read this book. The Word of God, taught to you by the Holy Spirit, will do very much to transform you.

If you are desperate to receive certain due victory from God, God is desperate to give it to you. But He needs you to come into faith so that He can hand it over to you. I trust the Lord that this book should get you there, if you follow the lessons within the pages.

Chapter One

What Os Faith?

"NOW FAITH is the assurance (the confirmation, the title deed) of the things [we] hope for, being the proof of things [we] do not see and the conviction of their reality [faith perceiving as real fact what is not revealed to the senses]."

Hebrews 11:1 AMP

t is important to begin from here. If you do not understand the definition of faith – what God says faith is – you will not know how to operate in it. Faith is like a house. You cannot build a house without a foundation. The foundation of everything we will receive from God is faith. Faith is the foundation upon which we build our relationship with God.

Faith is the proof you have that you have what you claim to have. Faith is our title deed. What is a title deed? A title deed is the deed that confirms your ownership of a thing.

Imagine I own a house and as I was about to get into the house, there's this stranger who is riling and railing about knocking me out of the house. My house.

I would simply not respond to him.

Rather, I would walk up to that porch and kick him off. Why? Because I know this is my house. I have the title deed to that house. That title deed makes me so confident and unafraid that I am sure he couldn't threaten me out of my house.

Faith is our title deed. It is the guarantee that we have from God



Faith is our title deed. The guarantee that we have from God what we say we have. what we say we have. And faith is always based upon the Word of God. In fact, the definition of faith is your complete believe in the Word of God. The rate of your success is actually determined by your believe in the Word of God.

If you believe the Word of God, whatever God says, then you have faith. As long as you believe the Word of God and are living by it, it doesn't matter how much the devil is attacking

your finances, your business, your family, your marriage, you know God's Word is true and you can kick him out.

Faith asks for no other evidence apart from the Word of God.

Faith is completely contrary to our five senses. The Bible says, "Faith perceiving as real fact what is not revealed to the senses." Your sense of smell, seeing, touch, feeling, cannot perceive it. Your body isn't feeling to well. You can tell it's going to be sick. But faith says,

"By His [Jesus] stripes, I am healed. It doesn't matter what my body is saying to me." How do you believe you have what you ask from God, even when the circumstances stays the same? Faith in God's Word, that you receive what you ask when you pray (Mark 11:24).

Faith is acting based on God's Word. When you act based on God's Word, you have acted on faith.

Let's look at John 2:5. This is the wedding at Cana of Galilee. Jesus, His disciples, and Mary His mother were there. The wine had been exhausted. But Mary knew that all things were possible with Jesus. Even manufacturing wine from nowhere.

What did she do? She knew exactly what pushed Jesus' button. She had been His mother all through thirty years of His life. She knew He was God's Son and having witnessed too many miracles with Him in the house (I should think so), she knew He could make things happen now. So, she told the servants.



Faith is doing whatever God says in His Word.

"Do whatever He says."

Mary knew the trick to pushing Jesus' power out. She knew the only way God could release His power. She knew it wasn't a matter of what Jesus said to her earlier but a matter of whether she could be smart enough to push His button.

Faith is "whatever He says to you, do it." You exercise faith when you do the Word of God. It is no more a matter of how you feel any more than it is a matter of what you do.

Most people think they must have great faith before they can do God's Word or receive from God. Actually, no. Faith simply acts upon God's Word. Faith asks for no other evidence.

Jesus told the disciples, "If you have faith like a mustard seed..." A mustard seed is a very tiny seed that is almost infinitesimal to the eyes. It is so tiny you may not be able to see it. But why would Jesus equate faith to this? Why should such tiny faith move a mountain?

The reason is simple: if you believe, you will act. It is not a matter of how great your faith is or how small. Much more, it is a matter of



If you believe, you will act.

your response to the Word of God. You will act wealthy if you believe "God will supply your need according to His riches in glory through Christ Jesus", even though you have nothing in your bank account.

Faith is, "Whatever He says to you, do it." Do what God says, regardless of what you think or

how you feel, and you would acted in faith. No matter whether your emotions or the physical circumstances line up with the Word of God. Faith simply acts on the Word of God.

If you believe God, if you believe His Word, you will do what it says. The evidence that you believe is revealed in what you do.

We behave what we believe. So whatever you're behaving right now is a result of what you believe.

For everyone who asks receives, and he who seeks finds, and to him who knocks it will be opened. Or what man is there among you who, if his son asks for bread, will give him a stone? Or if he asks for a fish, will he give him a serpent? If

you then, being evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father who is in heaven give good things to those who ask Him!"

In Luke 18:1, He says again to us, "Then He spoke a parable to them, that men always ought to pray and not lose heart."

John 14:13-14, 16:23-24, also talks about asking God.

John 14:13-14, "And whatever you ask in My name, that I will do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. If you ask anything in My name, I will do it."

God always want to give you. He is always waiting for you to ask John 16:23-24, "And in that day you will ask Me nothing. Most assuredly, I say to you, whatever you ask the Father in My name He will give you. Until now you have asked nothing in My name. Ask, and you will receive, that your joy may be full."

Why does the Bible emphasize praying to God?

Because God always want to give to you.

You may have asked for things in prayer and it seems the answers have not come. First, you must realise and understand it deeply that God always want to give to you.

The Bible declares, "Before you call, I will answer. While you're yet speaking, I will hear" (Isaiah 65:24).

God is not a lying Father. He is not a Father Who says one thing and means the other. If He says He always hears you before you call and answers you while you are yet speaking, you should believe it. You should come boldly before His throne, holding up this Word in your heart, knowing fully well that when you ask Him, He immediately answers.

You may say, "But I don't feel like I have what I have received what I asked." There's never anywhere in the Bible where we are told to feel we have received what we have asked before we get it. We are never told to feel. We are told to believe God heard us and we will do for us what we ask, if we asked according to His will – which is His Word.

Listen to me, if your son came to you to ask you, "Dad, our teacher told us to buy pencil in school."

If you are a good father (and I'm certain you are), you will not kick that son away. You will not tell him to shut up and walk away. You will not keep doing whatever you're doing and act like you didn't hear him.



When we love, we give. God gives us because He loves

US.

Because you love him, you will respond to him. You may not have the money at that

moment. But the love you have for him, especially when you know he isn't lying to you, will compel you to want to do for him.

See, when we love people we want to do for them. "For God so love the world that He gave..." (John 3:16). If God loves us so much like this, it is without doubt that that love will always compel Him to always want to give to us.

God is not stingy. God is not a Father Who wants you to beg and cry and whine before He gives you just one thing. God is very generous. He wants to always give you everything you need, so that in giving you, your joy may be full (John 16:24).

Imagine a Father Who is always very happy that He is giving you; who is always happy that you received something from Him. That is God, your Father.

Don't listen to the lies of the devil. Don't believe the deception of your flesh. God hears your prayer and longs to do for you, if you are

His child and are following Him. You should not give up on asking Him for what you need. Ask Him and He will give you. He will never lie.

Charge up your faith today. Ask God for your need. And thank Him because He will do it.

"Now to Him who is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that works in us."

Ephesians 3:20

ead through the Gospels. One of the most shocking discoveries you will make is that men receive only according to their faith. No way has heaven delivered great victory to any man without that man pulling it down by faith.

Too many times in the Gospels, Jesus told men, "According to your faith, be it unto you."

When He was going to heal the two blind men, He told them, 'According to your faith, be it unto you" (Matthew 9:29).

When He would heal the woman with the issue, He told her, "Your faith has made you whole" (Mark 5:34).

When He wanted to heal the paralytic man, scriptures, "When Jesus saw their faith..." (Matthew 9:2).

He constantly rebuked His disciples for their lack of faith (Matthew 8:26).

Faith is a prerequisite to receiving from God. You can never receive from God without faith. God gives His best to the man who has faith and lives by faith. In fact, I dare say that the man who has access to all that God has is the man who lives by faith and faith alone.

Jesus was this kind of man. He lived completely and absolutely by faith. And the Scriptures declare this about Him, "The Father loves the Son and has given all things into His hands." (John 3:35).

Do you think God gave Him all things because He was the Son?



God does nothing for us except by faith, because faith is what pleases God. Yes. And in Him, we equally have access to all things because Jesus Christ Himself said it. "As my Father loved me, I have also loved you" (John 15:9). The Father loved Him so much that He put all things in His hands. If He loves us the same way the Father loved Him, then it means He has equally committed all things into our hands.

But we gain access to all these things – all our rights, privileges and responsibilities – by faith. Faith is the cheque book for cashing all that is yours in God. If you show up in God's "bank" without faith, that cheque bounces. But God does not want this to keep happening to you. He wants you to have all that He has bequeathed to you in Christ Jesus. You can have it all by faith.

God wants to give you all He has prepared for you. You are not limited by anything except your faith. How much you can exercise your faith determines how much you will receive from God. In fact,

permit me to tell you that you have all have now according to your faith.

If you believe God for little, God cannot force much on you. God doesn't force anything upon us. He told Abraham, "As far as your eyes can see, that will I give unto you." If your faith sees farther than where you are now, God will honour your faith and give you what your faith.

God honours our faith because faith honours God. If a man could

believe God for his nation and God could give it to him, you can believe God for your finances, the souls of your children, your marriage, your business, your health, and you will have it.

It's never a matter how much God can do for you. It's always a matter of the limit you have placed on your own faith. Take away that limit by looking into God's Word and claiming for yourself what God has prepared for you.



The Word of God is God's letter to you, containing everything He has promised.

The Word of God is God's letter to you that contains everything He has promised. How much you open it and draw from it will determine how much of God's promises you will walk in.

Take away the limit today. As far as your faith can believe, God wants to give to you. You can't pity the resources of God because His resources are inexhaustible. Nothing you could ever ask would affect God's resources. He has more than abundant for all His children, and still more.

Kick the limit off your faith today. As far as your eyes can see, that's what God wants to give to you.

How far can your eyes see?

Seek No Other Evidence

"Then Jesus said to him, "Unless you people see signs and wonders, you will by no means believe."

John 4:48

an I tell you the truth? If you're still seeking evidence before you can have faith, you have no faith at all. If you're still seeking evidence before you can start to walk in the victory that is available to you in Christ Jesus, you have no faith.

Faith seeks no other evidence except the evidence of the Word of God. Once faith sees what God's Word says, it stands by it and remains unshaking through it. Faith holds on only to the Word of God and seeks no other evidence.

Let's read the Amplified translation of Hebrews 11:1, "NOW FAITH is the assurance (the confirmation, the title deed) of the things

[we] hope for, being the proof of things [we] do not see and the conviction of their reality [faith perceiving as real fact what is not revealed to the senses]."

Did you catch that? Faith perceives as real fact what is not revealed to the senses. Even when it is not real, even when physically I do not have it, even when I cannot taste it, smell it, see it, feel it, I believe it is real.

I believe that heaven is real. I believe that hell is real. I believe that God is real. Even though I cannot taste, see, feel, or smell them. Therefore, I believe that God's Word is real also. That I am healed when He says I am. That I can do all things through Christ Who gives me the strength.



We live by faith because we know God's Word is true. I have looked at my life, where I'm coming from and where I am at the moment. The transition that has happened, the changes, the transformation in character, habits, and behavior can only be linked to the Word of God.

There are giant situations that seemed immovable before me that, as soon as I trusted myself to God, I got my victory. I can't say that

I've perfected this faith walk. But each time I have had faith in God fully, I have seen great victory come my way time and time again.

Do you want to know and be utterly convinced that God loves you? Read it in His Word (Ephesians 2:4 AMPC). There's no other way to be secure in His love than to believe that He loves you because His Word says so. When the situation comes at you and wants you to deny God's love, you can look up God's Word and tell yourself, "I love Him because He first loved me. Therefore, I believe His love for me. Perfect love cast out fear" (1 John 4:16-18).

Seek no other evidence. Faith is the evidence you have that you have all that God says you have. Faith is evidence you have to prove that God is with you always even until the end of the age (Matthew 28:20). Faith is the evidence you have that all things will work together for your good (Romans 8:28).

If you can stay with this evidence, you can rest assured that you're standing right within your victory. Why is this so?

Because faith is the very victory that overcomes the world (1 John 5:4). The world including all circumstances in your life. No matter the circumstances.

Walk in the victory God has for you.




